4.	<p><b>Clause 2.19.1</b> Page 16 of the tender document As indicated in the scope of requirements, the products to be supported are from other different vendors whereas the requirements appear to be for only one vendor – Oracle. This appears to be an anomaly. Attached please see heightened anomaly.</p> <p>We therefore seek your clarification or addendum on the same.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The bidder must have a MAF for all the requested 6 products i.e. Oracle EBS Financial, Oracle EBS Supply Chain, Oracle Hyperion, Oracle SOA, Oracle BI and Oracle Database &amp; Options. In case of a Joint venture/Consortium/teaming agreement the lead/prime bidder <b>MUST</b> have a MAF for at least 3 of the requested products, the rest of the MAFs can be provided by the consortium partners.</li> <li>The bidder must have a <b>MINIMUM OF TWO (2) Oracle Partner Specialization or Advanced Specialization</b> as follows; <b>ONE FOR EITHER ORACLE FINANCIALS OR ORACLE SUPPLY CHAIN AND ONE FOR EITHER ORACLE BI OR ORACLE SOA</b>.
