Chart 1A: Economic Growth Rates (Percent)




Chart 1B: Per Capita Income (KSh thousands) and Jobs Generated (in Thousands)




Chart 1C: Gross Fixed Capital Formation, Gross Domestic Savings and Real GDP (Percentage Growth Rates)




Chart 2A: Short Term Interest Rates (Percent), January 2014 – May 2020




Chart 2B: Commercial Bank Interest Rates (Percent), January 2014 – March 2020







Chart 3: Growth in Money Supply (M3) and Overall Year-on-Year Inflation Rate (%), January 2014 – April 2020
















Chart 5B: Composition of Government Expenditure in FY 2019/20*





Chart 6: Composition of Government Domestic Debt (FY 2012/13 - FY 2018/19*)





Chart 9: Performance of the Nairobi Securities Exchange (January 2014 – May 2020)




Chart 10: Foreign Exchange Reserves (January 2014 – April 2020)




Chart 11: Composition of Imports by Broad Economic Activity, 2019





Chart 12: Composition of Exports by Broad Economic Activity, 2019
